

Frequently Asked Questions

What are entry numbers? Why do we need to remember them?

- Each entry is given a unique number according to its category; you can view the entry numbers in the competition program, or online after April 26. Finalists in the Performance and Documentary categories are posted by entry number.

What time do I/does my child need to be at their judging area?

- Students should be at their judging area at least 20 minutes before their scheduled time.

How can I find my child/spouse/teacher?

- Go to the Registration tables in the North Classroom Atrium to see if your child has checked in. (For Exhibits, go to the lobby of the PE/Event Center)
- Go to their judging room. Room assignments and times for performances/documentaries or interviews are listed in the competition program

Where can we find something to eat?

- There are several fast-food restaurants on the bottom floor of the Tivoli Student Union, and other options around the campus. See the competition program for more ideas
- There are dozens of choices just a few blocks away in downtown Denver. Stop by the History Day in Colorado information table in the North Classroom Atrium for suggestions and maps

Can the public view the competition?

- Exhibit, paper and web site entries will be open for public viewing in the PE/Event Center from 12:00-1:00 p.m. and from 2:00-4:00 p.m. However, the interviews in these categories are not open to the public
- Performances and Documentaries are open to the public in both the preliminary and final rounds.

How do we know if we need to be present for the final round?

- Finalists in all categories will be posted to the public at 12:30 in various locations. Please consult the History Day in Colorado web site after April 26 for more information.

What can we do while we wait?

- Visit the Information table in the North Classroom Atrium for some ideas!

When are the winners announced for each category?

- Final results for all categories will be announced at the Awards Ceremony in the PE/Events Center at 5:00.

When and where is the Awards Ceremony?

- 5:00-6:00 p.m. in the PE/Events Center

How can I enter the Prize Drawing and when will the drawing take place?

- Participants, parents and teachers can enter the drawing by completing an evaluation form. Evaluation forms are available in the North Classroom Atrium; turn in your evaluation form by 4:00.
- Prizes will be drawn during the Awards Ceremony

How do I get my judging forms?

- Your teacher will pick up your judging form after the Awards Ceremony

National Competition: Who, When, Where?

- **Who:** The top two finishers in each category qualify for nationals. Third place serves as alternate.
- **When:** June 12-17
- **Where:** The University of Maryland, College Park (in the Washington, D.C. area)
- **National qualifiers should stay for the State Winners Meeting following the Awards Ceremony.**
